

DLSS COMPETITIONS CODE OF CONDUCT

By participating in a DLSS competition, you agree to the following DLSS Competitions Code of Conduct.

- Upon being provided notice of the Code of Conduct in addition to the scenario brief, the time to withdraw from the competition will expire. Any attempts to withdraw from the competition from this point onwards will be in contravention of the DLSS Competitions Code of Conduct.
- 2. Competitors must email a member of the Competitions team soon as possible if they are unable to participate due to exceptional circumstances.
- 3. Only general feedback will be provided by the judge. Scoresheets may be requested at the end of each round.
- 4. All communication with the DLSS competitions team must take place via email unless otherwise permitted.
- 5. Competitors must arrive 10 minutes early to their allocated timeslot, whether in-person or via Zoom.
- 6. Communicating with other competitors about competition material is strictly prohibited. Evidence of collusion may result in disqualification from this competition and future DLSS competitions.
- 7. All DLSS competitions emails, during the course of the competition, must be replied to within 24 hours. Failure to correspond may render the Competitions Team unable to allocate you a competition time slot.
- 8. Additional requirements may be stipulated by the Competitions Team. Including the speaking times of the parties, and whether written submissions are required.
- 9. Competitors agree to act in good faith throughout the competition process.
- 10. The DLSS Competitor Code of Conduct should be read in conjunction with the DLSS Competitions Rules. Any breaches should be reported to the *DLSS Internal Competitions Dispute Form* available on the DLSS website.
- 11. All decisions communicated by the Competitions Team are final.
